A Short History of Kindergarten - German Roots

German Fredrich Fröbel (1782-1852) founded the first kindergarten in 1838. He created this 'play' environment as an experimental social experience for children about to enter school. Up until then, most emphasis in childhood education was based on rote learning and strict behavior. Fröbel's approach was to let the children be nurtured and nourished 'like plants in a garden.' Kindergarten Spreads to the United States

The first kindergarten in the USA was founded in Watertown, Wisconsin in 1856 by Margaretha Meyer-Schurz and was conducted in German. Elizabeth Peabody founded the first English language kindergarten in 1860.

CONSTITUTION MINUTE

February Dates of Note

FEBRUARY 3: THE FIRST PAPER MONEY IN AMERICA IS ISSUED IN THE MASSACHUSETTS B<mark>AY COLONY (1690).</mark>

FEBRUARY 4: THE UNITED SERVICE ORGANIZATIONS (USO) IS FORMED TO CATER TO THE ARMED FORCES AND DEFENSE INDUSTRIES (1941).

FEBRUARY 12: ABRAHAM LINCOLN IS BORN NEAR HODGENVILLE, KY., THE SECOND CHILD AND FIRST SON OF THOMAS AND NANCY HANKS LINCOLN (1809).

FEBRUARY 24: SOME 3,000 MEXICANS UNDER SANTA ANNA LAUNCH AN ASSAULT ON THE ALAMO WITH ITS 182 TEXAN DEFENDERS (1836).

FEBRUARY 26: THE 22ND AMENDMENT IS ADDED TO THE CONSTITUTION, LIMITING THE PRESIDENCY TO TWO TERMS (1951).

FEBRUARY 27: CONGRESS PASSES THE 15TH AMENDMENT, WHICH GUARANTEES CITIZENS THE RIGHT TO VOTE REGARDLESS OF "RACE, COLOR, OR PREVIOUS CONDITION OF SERVITUDE." BECOMING LAW ON MARCH 30, 1870, IT DOES NOT SPECIFY THAT IT APPLIES ONLY TO "MALE INHABITANTS," AS THE 14TH AMENDMENT DOES, BUT IT WILL BE ADMINISTERED AS IF IT DOES (1869).

CONSTITUTION MINUTE – PREAMBLE / DECLARATION THE PREAMBLE TO THE CONSTITUTION DOES NOT STATE THAT "ALL MEN ARE CREATED EQUAL." THIS STATEMENT IS IN THE PREAMBLE OF THE DECLARATION OF INDEPENDENCE. HOWEVER, THE CONSTITUTION PREAMBLE DOES STATE THAT THE "PEOPLE" (REFERRING TO THE CITIZENS OF THE COUNTRY) ARE THE GOVERNMENT. THIS MEANS THAT THE GOVERNMENT EXISTS TO SERVE ITS CITIZENS RATHER THAN THE CITIZENS EXISTING TO SERVE THE GOVERNMENT. FURTHERMORE, IT DEFINES THE PURPOSE OF THE GOVERNMENT CREATED BY THE CONSTITUTION. THE PURPOSE IS TO ESTABLISH JUSTICE (A SOCIETY BASED ON THE RULE OF LAW), ENSURE PEACE AT HOME, MAINTAIN THE SECURE DEFENSE OF THE COUNTRY, PROMOTE THE WELL-BEING OF THE PEOPLE, AND ENSURE THAT THE BLESSINGS CONFERRED BY THE INNATE GIFT OF LIBERTY ARE SAFEGUARDED FOREVER. THE ARTICLES WITHIN THE CONSTITUTION CREATE THE FRAMEWORK OF HOW THE GOVERNMENT WILL DO JUST THAT.
